Changes in Epidemiology of Colorectal Cancer


Cancer historically has been considered a disease affecting older adults.

Between 1990 and 2019, cancer rates among those under 50 rose by 79% with colorectal cancer being notably prevalent in this age group.

Catch more cases early.

Reduce mortality.


Improve long-term outcomes.





Screening Options at 45

- Colonoscopy (Gold Standard): Every 10 years if no abnormalities
- Non-invasive Stool Tests (FIT, gFOBT, or Cologuard): Every 1–3 years
- CT Colonography or Flex
 Sigmoidoscopy: Every 5 years

Accurate EMR documentation and billing are more important than ever to ensure proper care tracking.


